

Pet Preparedness

Essential Items

- Collar with identification tags
- Leash or harness
- Water and bowls
- Food for at least one full week
- Crate or carrier
- Printed vaccination records
- Pet-specific medication
- Printed veterinarian contact information
- Printed photo of your pet
- Blankets and towels
- Potty pads and waste bags
- Litter and disposable litter box

Tips & Tricks for Pet Preparedness:

Find It: Identify pet-friendly evacuation shelters or locations ahead of time so you can stay with your pet during an evacuation. Have conversations with trusted family and friends that may be able to assist if you need to separate from your pet in an emergency.

Add It: Have extra space or supplies? Add other essentials that are personal to your pet and can help in times of stress. This could be toys, treats, or comfort items.

Store It: Put your supplies in one or two easy-to-carry containers such as plastic bins or a backpack. Keep the supplies somewhere easy to retrieve – make sure it is easy to grab!

Maintain It: Always check the contents of your kit and replace items as needed or as they expire!
