



PREGNANT?

Pregnancy or related conditions include: (1) Pregnancy, childbirth, termination of pregnancy, or lactation; (2) Medical conditions related to these conditions; and (3) Recovery from these conditions.

The Title IX Office can coordinate specific actions to prevent sex discrimination and ensure equal access to the WSSU's education program or activity.

Reasonable adjustments can be made if approved by the Title IX Coordinator. These adjustments may include:

1. Making modifications to the physical environment, such as accessible seating.
2. Extending deadlines and/or allowing the student to make up tests or assignments missed for pregnancy-related reasons.
3. Granting leave per the University's medical leave policy or implementing incomplete grades for classes that will be resumed at a future date.
4. Allow breastfeeding students reasonable time and space to pump breast milk in a private, clean, and reasonably accessible location.
