Essentials

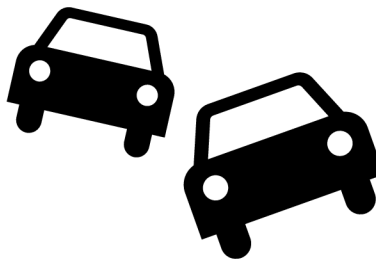
- Water

Tips & Tricks for Vehicle Preparedness:

Learn It: Learn how to do basic preparedness and maintenance checks on your vehicle. Know how to “pop the hood” or which lever releases the hood of the car. Learn how jumper cables work to jump a dead car battery, before you need it!

Add It: Have extra space or supplies? Add other essentials that are personal to you or your environment, or will help you in times of stress.

Store It: Put your supplies in one or two easy-to-carry containers such as plastic bins or a backpack. Keep the supplies somewhere easy to retrieve - don’t bury it under your trunk!

Maintain It: Always check the contents of your kit and replace items as needed or as they expire!
