Election Qualifications

- Must a student of Winston-Salem State University and have been for at least two semesters prior to election.
- Must have completed the appropriate hours required for the position sought and not have any incompletes on transcript.
- Must be a full-time student and continuously enrolled during the academic year in which the office is held.
- Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of a 2.7 at the time of application and maintain, while in office, a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
 - o All students applying for the position of SGA President must have a minimum cumulative GPA of a 3.0 at the time of application and maintain, while in office, a minimum 2.7cummualtive GPA.
